### Friday May 1st 7-9pm - Belly Mapping with Gail Tully

*For parents, soon-to-be-parents, birth practitioners, childbirth educators, midwives*

“Belly Mapping is a way that a mother can tell for herself what her baby's position is--during the last month or two of pregnancy. Too often, the posterior (sunny-side up) baby isn't identified until labor is troubled. Mothers ask, sometimes after the cesarean for a long, OP labor, ‘Why didn't anybody know? Can't the nurse or doctor tell when doing an exam?’ Medical studies compare ultrasound imagining with vaginal exams by nurses and doctors. Trying to feel with the fingers which way a baby's head was directed was not possible 60% of the time in the first stage of labor and 30% of the time in the second stage.
